


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CENTRAL OKLAHOMA

 - 46,550,000 (2040)





City Boundary









COMMUTER CORRIDORS STUDY

- Each Corridor was Evaluated for the Four Modes
- Public Meetings were held Locally to Gather Feedback
- Number of Passengers, Travel Time, Ridership Numbers were Generated
- An Enhanced ACOG Travel Demand Model to Accept Commuter Rail
- Preliminary Station Locations were Determined
- Further Discussions of Transit Oriented Development (TOD)

LOCALLY PREFERRED ALTERNATES

Approval of LPAs:

- July 2014 RTD Steering Committee Selected LPAs
- October 2014 ACOG Board Approved the LPAs

Three Corridor LPAs:

- North Corridor:
 - Downtown OKC <-> Downtown Edmond
- South Corridor:
 - Downtown OKC <-> Moore, Norman
- East Corridor:
 - Downtown OKC <-> Del City, Midwest City, Tinker AFB



NORTH CORRIDOR

- Commuter Rail to Edmond
- Capital Cost: (2014)
 - Commuter Rail: \$260-360 Million
 - Streetcar: \$270-370 Million
- Estimated Daily Ridership:
 - Commuter Rail: 1,970







SOUTH CORRIDOR

- Commuter Rail
- Santa Fe Station to Norman (Highway 9)
 - Thru-service to Edmond
- Capital Cost: (2014)
 \$310-410 Million
- Estimated Daily Ridership:3,060



EAST CORRIDOR

- Streetcar
- OKC to Tinker
- Capital Cost: (2014)
 \$320-440 Million
- Estimated Daily Ridership: 2,300





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HB 2480

AMENDED PREVIOUS LEGISLATION | 68 O.S. 2011, SEC. 1370.7

- RTD Member Rep. Charlie Joyner
- OKC Chamber Lobbied and Advocated
- Signed by Governor Fallin May 22, 2014
- Allowed for creation of Regional Districts
- Any combination of any portions of cities, towns or counties
- Staffing and Operating added to definition of "operations"
- Governed by Board of Directors appointed by creating entities
- Funding Option = Sales Tax Only


